

LAGOON OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

This course provides the purpose and function of Wastewater Treatment Ponds (Lagoons). The class will include the Operation, Maintenance, Troubleshooting, and Optimization of Wastewater Ponds, including lagoon microbiology/chemistry and the need for process control. Rules and regulations will be reviewed, including NPDES Permits, NETDMR and FOG ordinances. Hands-on activities and classroom participation will enable operators to recognize and describe everyday observations of poor treatment by using example evaluation findings, and the correlation between violations and absent O & M activity.
